

Hosting stakeholder workshops to update the plan





Water Research Foundation Collaboration



The project addresses:

- Impact on flow and sedimentation due to projected land use change
- Areas that may potentially have significantly higher impacts on flow and sedimentation ("hot spots")
- Extent land conservation may mitigate impacts
- Optimum combination of conservation actions in the watershed

Current Status


Developed detailed water loss profiles and statistical analysis for each CWWMG member
